We address challenges facing poor and vulnerable groups, particularly in the Global South. The Sustainable Development Goals frame our research agenda.




We take pride in quality research, but know that change and development also depend on our interaction and dialogue with stakeholders and policy makers.

Our research agenda is anchored in global challenges and the SDGs. We develop new knowledge that addresses the huge global inequalities in human life conditions.




DIALOGUE WITH USERS
