Carmeliza Rosário is a Social and Development Anthropology, with working experience in poverty, vulnerability, inequality and gender. Her main country of research is Mozambique. She has additional experience in Southern, Central, Western and Eastern Africa.

Her current research focuses on the dynamics of female traditional leadership, and is part of the project [Cabo Delgado: Conflict, Resilience and Reconstruction](#). The project's objective is to provide inputs to better understand the causes of the conflict in Cabo Delgado province, with a view to promoting economic reconstruction, social cohesion and violence prevention.

Previously, Rosario participated in a number of longitudinal research projects and consultancies on poverty, gender, rights and health. She was part of a joint CMI/UIB project entitled "[Political determinants of sexual and reproductive health: Criminalisation, health impacts and game changers](#)", located at the [Centre for Law and Social Transformation](#).

Rosario also has extensive experience in program evaluations.
